A guide to help families understand the
funding options at LBO



GOVERNMENT FUNDING



How is Government Funding Applied Throughout the Year?

The government offers up to 30 funded hours per week, but to ensure year-round support, this funding is stretched over 51 weeks. This means families can claim up to 22 hours per week instead of 30, ensuring a consistent allocation of childcare hours across the full nursery year.

Who is Eligible for Funded Nursery Places?

- 9 months to 3 years: Eligible children can receive 11 funded hours per week if they meet government criteria.
- 3 to 5 years: Eligible children can receive 22 funded hours per week
- All 3- and 4-year-olds are entitled to 11 hours per week, regardless of eligibility.

Changes from September 2025

- All children aged 9 months to 4 years can access up to 22 funded hours if parents meet eligibility criteria.
- Some 2-year-olds can receive 11 hours if parents claim certain benefits.
- All 3- and 4-year-olds continue to receive up to 11 hours, regardless of eligibility.

This expansion ensures more families have access to affordable early years education.

GOVERNMENT FUNDING

The government's Early Years Funding covers the delivery of the statutory Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS). All children at Little Barn Owls receive the full EYFS curriculum and care.

Many families choose our enhanced package, which includes a wider range of enriched experiences and services beyond the EYFS requirements. These elements are not covered by the funded entitlement and therefore incur an Additional Services Charge.

Enhanced Nursery Package

This package includes all enriched experiences and services that form part of the Little Barn Owls approach, including meals, Forest School/Farm School, atelier provision, consumables and enhanced materials.

Funded-Only Option

Children accessing the funded-only option receive the full EYFS curriculum. Families may choose this option without purchasing additional enriched services. Optional extras may be available depending on the nursery site and programme.

FULL PACKAGE

EYFE ONLY PACKAGE



Our EYFE-only Package is covered entirely by government funding and allows families to use up to 11 or 22 hours of funded entitlement per week (15 or 30 hours spread across 51 weeks of the year).

This package includes:

- ✓ Standard Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) provision
- ✓ A safe and nurturing environment
- ✓ Engaging activities that support early development

This package does not include our LBO Enhanced Provision. EYFE-only bookings do not include:

- ✗ Meals, snacks, nappies, sun cream
- ✗ Farm School
- ✗ Forest School
- ✗ Atelier sessions with Artist in Residence
- ✗ Enriched provision (experiences beyond the EYFS - see Full Package details)
- ✗ Special Events and Ceremonies (Graduation, Parent Events, Seasonal Events)
- ✗ Project Shares / documentation for extended projects (beyond EYFS)

Optional extras may be available depending on the nursery site and programme.

Cost Breakdown of the Full Package

The Full Package is carefully priced at £18 per fully funded day, covering all the additional benefits your child will receive:

EYFE-only details

The EYFE-only Package ensures quality early education, but does not provide the additional opportunities that enhance your child's learning journey.

Food is not included in the EYFE-only package, however, at a small additional surcharge of **£10 per day**, EYFE-only children can opt-in to the full **Meals Service** to cover all meals and snacks. We encourage parents to opt-in so that their children can benefit from freshly prepared, healthy food throughout the day (up to 3 meals and 3 snacks).

Families choosing to opt-out of the meal service must provide sufficient food for the full nursery day. All food coming into nursery must comply with our 'Meals from Home' Policy in order to mitigate risks to children in nursery with serious allergies.

Parents will be required to provide all consumables daily, packed into the child's bag. This **MUST** include:

- Sun cream

- Nappies (where needed)

- Wet wipes

- Nappy sacks

- Nappy creams

In the event of items being forgotten, 'Emergency Consumables Charges' will apply.

Extra-curricular trips/outings and activities are voluntary. If taken up, parents are responsible for covering some or all of the associated costs.

FUNDING PACKAGE COMPARISON



Little Barn Owls Forest and Farm School Nurseries offer two packages for parents claiming government funded hours.

As of April 2025, prospective families will be asked to opt for one of two funding packages.

Please be aware that, as per our Admissions Policy, Full Package bookings are prioritised over EYFE-Only bookings in the event of there being a waiting list
